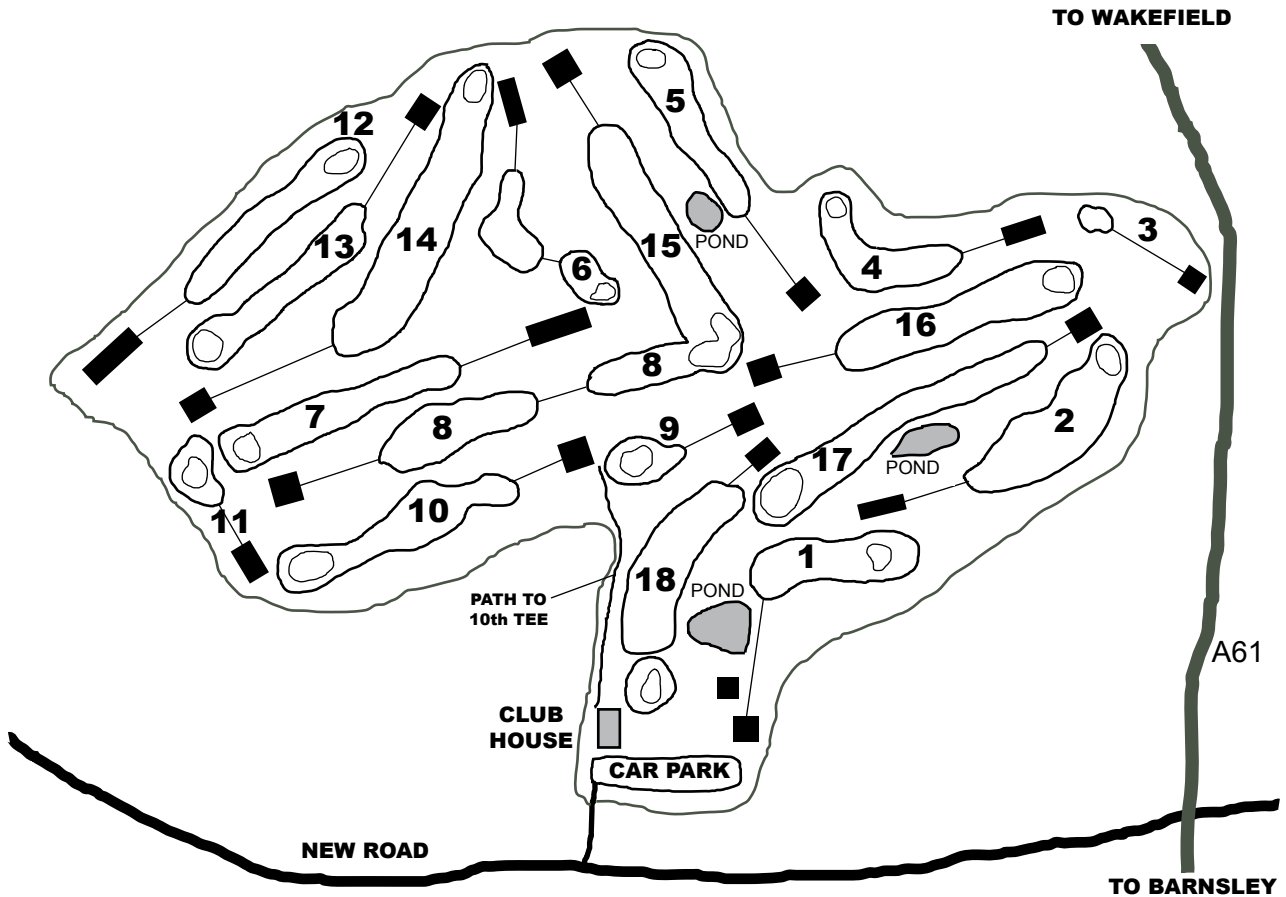

LOCAL RULES

1. **OUT OF BOUNDS.** Rule 27
 - a) Beyond all Boundary Walls, Hedges and Fences.
 - b) When playing hole 1, beyond the white line on the right which surrounds the woodland.
 - c) When playing hole 4, beyond the white line on the right of the fairway.
 - d) When playing hole 14, beyond the white line on the left of the fairway.
 - e) When playing hole 18, on or beyond any part of the path which runs between 18th Green and the Putting Green, also the grassy area which contains the Gas Tank and Buggy Parking Area (defined by a white line/posts).
 - f) In, or on the Clubhouse, Carpark, Gardens, Paths, Patio, or that part of the Road alongside the Clubhouse and car park.
 2. **WATER HAZARDS.** Rule 26-1
All ponds and ditches are Water Hazards when defined by Yellow Posts or Lines.
 3. **STONES IN BUNKERS** are movable obstructions, relief is available under Rule 24-1.
 4. **PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES** identified by stakes or tree collars. If such a tree is in danger from the Player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b(i) (Immovable Obstruction). The ball may be cleaned when so lifted).
 5. **FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS**
All fixed sprinkler heads are Immovable Obstructions and relief from them is available under Rule 24-2.
 6. **OVERHEAD WIRES**
If a ball strikes an overhead power line the player must disregard the stroke, abandon the ball and play another ball as nearly as possible from the spot where the original ball was played, in accordance with Rule 20-5.
 7. **INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE**
All gardened areas within the course boundaries, roads, paths and tracks are integral parts of the course and the ball must be played as it lies, or relief taken under Rule 28, (Ball Unplayable). Except as follows:-
The red paths on the 1st and 2nd holes and the red path which links the 5th green to the 14th green. These are not integral parts of the course and relief is available under Rule 24-2.
 8. **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS**
The icehouse and fence on Hole 2 (but not the tree adjacent to it) and the sewage treatment plant on Hole 18 are immovable obstructions; relief is available under Rule 24-2.
 9. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR**
Play is not permitted from ground under repair, relief is available under Rule 25-1.
Play is not permitted from any temporary green when playing to a main green and vice-versa, relief is available under Rule 25-3.
- PENALTY CLAUSE**
Penalty for breach of these local rules not covered by a Rule of Golf:-
Matchplay ----- Loss of Hole
Strokeplay ----- 2 Strokes
